<b>Description</b>	the students develop their speaking abilities in Japanese on B1 level (intermediate) - they develop their fluency, linguistic accuracy and pronunciation. Also, they develop their communicational skills and interaction skills. Additionally they get familiarized with the specificity of Japanese business etiquette and knowledge about Japanese social life. The major emphasis is put on the vocabulary development (especially theme oriented - due to the covered material in class) and development of the language and cultural awareness. In class, the lecturer may use various topics which enable discussion and engage students to work in class encouraging their interest development
