Description	Second year students during their teaching practice, under supervision of a qualified teacher of English employed at school, prepare, carry out, discuss and document their own lessons of English, which enables the trainees to learn the principles of teaching and to reflect on the ways of putting into practice the theories, methods and techniques learned by the trainees during their studies.

After finishing the teaching practice the students prepare a report of their teaching containing the description of their activities and conclusions from the practice, which is confirmed by the mentors with their signatures. Next the mentor writes the opinion of the practice in which the content of the lessons, the thoroughness of the plan, the ability to use the theory in teaching practice and the ability to form observations of the teaching process on the basis of the student own teaching experience is evaluated. The students enclose the opinion and the lesson plans to the documentation. Selected lesson plans are evaluated by the university teaching practice coordinator.
